SURAT EDARAN PIKM KE-29/2026: **MAKLUMAN PINDAAN JADUAL KEDUA AKTA SENJATA 1960 -** **PERUBAHAN FI DAN PROSEDUR PENYIMPANAN SENJATA API**

Adalah dimaklumkan bahawa Kerajaan telahewartakan **Peraturan-peraturan Senjata (Pindaan Jadual Kedua) 2026** di bawah **Akta Senjata 1960** [Akta 206] yang melibatkan perubahan kadar fi permit, lesen serta fi berkaitan penyimpanan senjata api. Pindaan tersebut telah berkuat kuasa sebagaimana yang diperuntukkan dalam Warta Kerajaan P.U. (A) 94 bertarikh 20 Februari 2026.

2. Sila ambil maklum perubahan kadar fi baharu seperti berikut:

2.1 **Pistol atau Revolver:** Fi permit untuk membawa dan menggunakannya telah dinaikkan kepada **RM500** (daripada RM100 sebelum ini). (**Jadual Kedua, Perenggan 2(d)(iii)**)

2.2 **Shotgun:** Fi permit untuk membawa dan menggunakan setiap shotgun kekal tidak berubah pada kadar **RM50**. (**Jadual Kedua, Perenggan 2(b)(ii) dan 2(b)(iv)**)

2.3 Lesen untuk **membeli, memperoleh atau memindahkan peluru** dinaikkan kepada RM100 (daripada RM2.00 sebelum ini). (**Jadual Kedua, Perenggan 4**).

3. Selain itu, berdasarkan warta kerajaan terkini, **ahli kini dibenarkan untuk menyimpan senjata api di balai polis yang ditetapkan**. Sila ambil perhatian bahawa caj perkhidmatan simpanan sebanyak **RM10** dikenakan bagi setiap senjata api sebagaimana diperuntukkan di bawah **Jadual Kedua, Perenggan 22(b)**.

4. Persatuan mengambil maklum bahawa pelaksanaan fi baharu ini melibatkan kenaikan yang pasti memberi implikasi tambahan kepada kos operasi ahli-ahli, terutamanya fi permit untuk membawa dan menggunakan pistol atau revolver. Pihak PIKM sedang dalam proses mengemukakan surat rayuan rasmi kepada Kementerian Dalam Negeri (KDN) untuk memohon pihak Kerajaan meneliti semula serta mempertimbangkan pengurangan atau pengecualian ke atas fi-fi tertentu. Maklum balas ahli-ahli mengenai kesan kenaikan fi ini

diperlukan untuk dimasukkan ke dalam kertas kerja rayuan berkenaan. Sila isi borang di pautan <https://forms.gle/pYVGqUmLfHkDXCc78> sebelum atau pada 12 Ogos 2026 (Rabu).

ARMS ACT 1960

ARMS (AMENDMENT OF SECOND SCHEDULE) REGULATIONS 2026

IN exercise of the powers conferred by section 59 of the Arms Act 1960 [Act 206], the Minister makes the following regulations:

Citation

1. These regulations may be cited as the **Arms (Amendment of Second Schedule) Regulations 2026**.

Substitution of Second Schedule

2. The Arms Act 1960 is amended by substituting for the Second Schedule the following schedule:
